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Selection Committee and Criteria Information

The Onalaska Alumni Association in partnership with the School District of Onalaska established the “Wall of Excellence” to recognize outstanding achievement and service to Onalaska High School by its alumni, faculty, and community members.

Location: High School Commons Entryway Title: Onalaska High School “Wall of Excellence”

Funding: Alumni Association Donations

Nominations Due: April 26, 2024

The Selection Committee shall consist of ten (10) voting members including:

- Current High School Principal
- One (1) Student Council Representative
- Three (3) Current Faculty Members
- Five (5) Alumni Association Representatives

All nominees must have biographical information on file.

The voting process will be done by written ballot.

A minimum of eight members of the Selection Committee must be present for voting to take place.

A nominee must get an 80% majority vote to be inducted onto the Wall of Excellence. Nominations are unlimited.

A second vote will take place for any nominee with more than a 50% vote.

The maximum number of inductees allowed per year is three (3).

Selection Criteria:

1. The number of Inductees shall be no more than three per year.
2. An alum being nominated must be at least ten (10) years past their graduation.
3. Faculty or administration must be inactive or retired from the school for at least five (5) years.
4. There is no minimum time requirement to be eligible as a community member being nominated for service or support to the school.

Induction: Annually during a home football game. (Traditionally September or October)
